After careful consideration of the information that I have been able to obtain about the ongoing dispute between Nerium Biotechnology and Nerium International, the current marketer for your skin care products, it is my opinion that it is in the best interests of all the shareholders that I vote the 3,004,468 shares of Nerium Biotechnology that are held by me, my entities, and my family members for the current management and board of directors. I will vote on the GREEN PROXY.

While it appears that the Federal Court will have to determine the factual matters of the dispute, the one fact that I have been able to determine is that both parties to the dispute have told me that Nerium International sold approximately HALF A BILLION DOLLARS of products, and yet LOST approximately two million dollars. It is my opinion that this describes a failed business model. And yet the "Shareholders Group" that is opposing current management has stated its intent to force Nerium Biotechnology to continue this failed relationship if they are successful in unseating current management.

Additionally, Lou Kost has informed me that he and his entities and family members intend to vote 1,639,775 for the current management and board of directors on the GREEN PROXY.

Dr. Sadik al Bassam, Nerium Biotechnology's largest shareholder, has informed me that he intends to vote 3,253,783 shares in favor of the current management and board of directors on the GREEN PROXY.

Dr. Robert Newman, the Chief Science Officer of Nerium Biotechnology, has informed me that unlike what the "Shareholder Group" has represented in their letter to the shareholders, he intends to vote his 400,000 shares for current management and the board of directors on the GREEN PROXY.

While it is ultimately up to each shareholder to determine for themselves which slate that they will vote for, it is my opinion that it is in the best interests of all the shareholders to vote for the current management and board of directors on the GREEN PROXY.
